Roadworks Update

N4 Longford Bypass Pavement Resurfacing Scheme Phase 1

The resurfacing scheme in place on the N4 Longford By-Pass is ongoing. Currently works is ongoing between the Red Cow Roundabout and Charlotte Brooke Roundabout. Resurfacing works are being carried out at Night-time to minimise disruption to traffic.

From the 11th of July, the placing of the Surface Course will commence. This work will be carried out at night-time (7pm to 4am) and will cause additional disruption.

The placing of wearing course on the Red Cow Roundabout will require a night-time junction closure of the Battery Road and Drumlish Road approaches onto the roundabout.

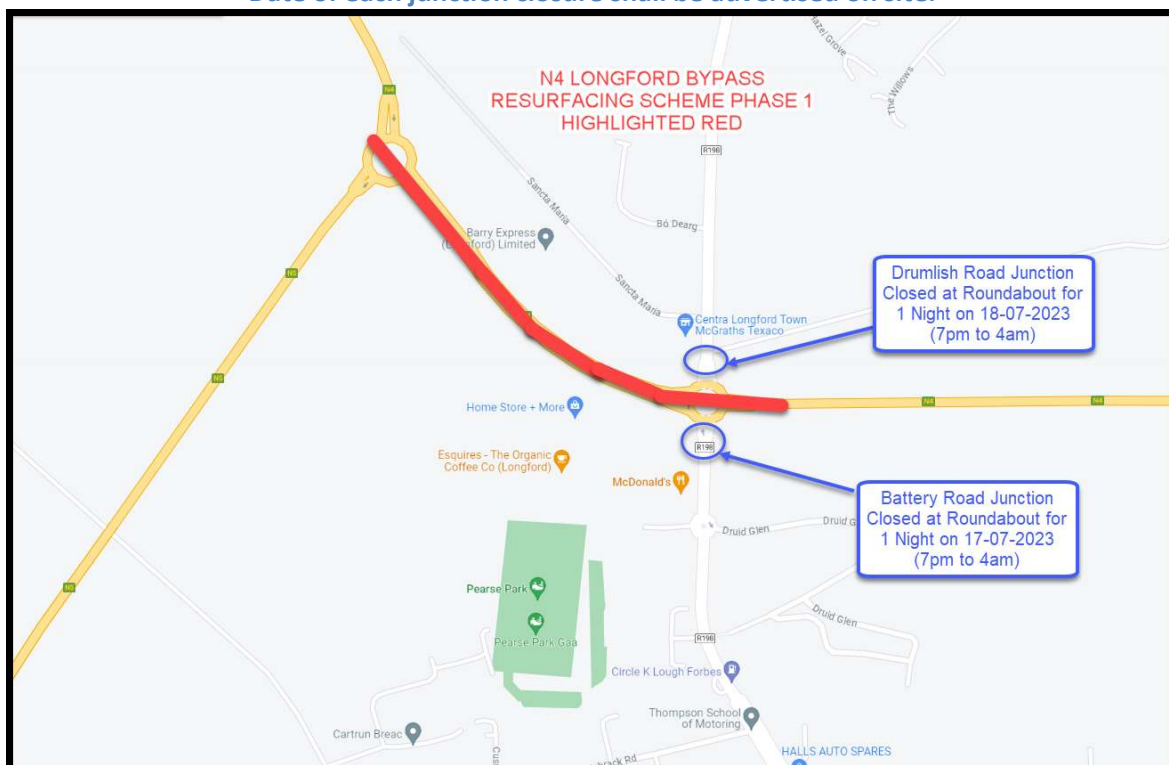
These closures are planned for the hours of 7pm to 4am on the following nights;

- **17th July 2023 – R198 (Battery Road Junction) closed at its approach to the roundabout. (Access to N4 via Town Centre to N63 Ballinalee Road)**
- **18th July 2023 – R194 Drumlish Road closed at its approach to the roundabout. (Access to N4 via R194 Ballinalee Road to Kiernan’s Forge, to Cahanagh Cross & onto the R198)**

The N4 will remain open at all times.

On completion of resurfacing at the Red Cow & Charlotte Brooke Roundabout, works will then commence on the N4 from the Ballinalee Road Roundabout to the Padraic Colum Roundabout.

Date of each junction closure shall be advertised on site.
