The following clerical errors have been identified in the Chief Executive's Report, issued to Elected Members on the 30th March 2021:

Chief Executive Report - Part 1:

In respect of Recommendation CE CH 11.1, in response to submission DCDP-16 referenced the incorrect Record of Protected Structure for deletion from the register and was specified in Part 1 of the Chief Executive's Report. The recommendation CE CH 11.1 confirmed RPS no. 269 as the referenced structure to be deleted from the register. However the correct RPS reference recommended for deletion from the Draft Plan register of protected structures was wrongly identified and should have read RPS no. 360.

Chief Executive Report – Part 2:

In respect of Part 2 of the Chief Executive's Report Recommendation CE AP 6.1, in response to submission DCDP-16 referenced the incorrect Record of Protected Structure for deletion from the register. The recommendation CE AP 6.1 confirmed RPS no. 269 as the referenced structure to be deleted from the register. The correct RPS reference recommended for deletion from the Draft Plan register of protected structures was wrongly identified and should have read RPS no. 360.

In respect of Part 2 of the Chief Executives Report land-use zoning submissions, there was an omission of submission DCDP no.89 land zoning received from Will Design on behalf of Mr. K Donnelly reference to a parcel of land in the rural settlement cluster of Melview. The assessment of the submission and the recommendation of the Chief Executive in respect of the proposed zoning in Melview rural settlement cluster has now been included in the Chief Executive's report – Part 2 corrected.
