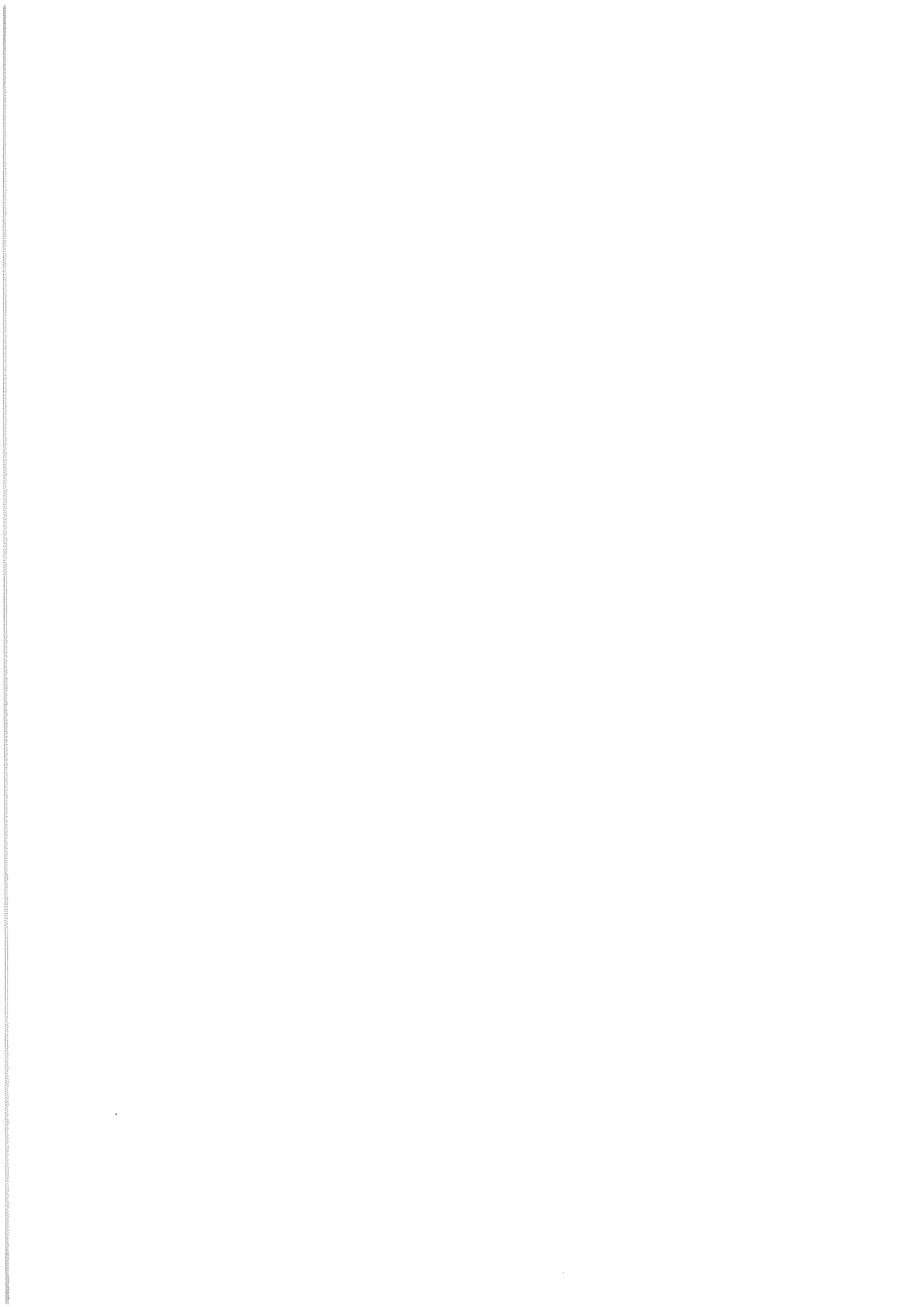

DRUMLISH SUBMISSIONS FOR COUNTY LONGFORD DEVELOPMENT PLAN 2021-2027

Please refer to attached map

1. School ground / community use to accommodate more great space
Rezone land from residential to social, community & education as marked on map
2. Amenity site (green space) opposite community centre & school to allow for additional extension to carpark.- due to high volume at school and Community Centre.
3. New graveyard marked on map also field behind- future burial ground
4. Strategic residential reserve site opposite Sliabhe Caribe to be amended to recreational green field
5. The Mill – marked as historical – with the hope it may be brought back working in the future.
6. Continuation of footpath on Old school Rd to junction of Hill St. (safety)
7. Upgrade footpath along Main St & Mohill road (safety)
8. To complete the development of Bishop O Higgins trail connecting the Barraghbeg to Mohill road. – tourist / walking trail
9. The site on R198 (corner of Derwaley / R198) remain as residential reserve.
10. Site for independent living accommodation –include in strategic residential reserve
(Possible rezoning of land at No 10) also to include Medical Centre that will accommodate all services and increase in population.
11. Re use old landfill site as solar panel farm
12. Footpath from the junction Longford Rd /Newtownforbes Rd to extend past all residence on left
13. Improve buildings in middle of village left unattended (Improve image of village)

- Upgrade and further develop Drumlish Library
- Provision of site to relocate the men's shed
- Due to the lack of green space within the village, provision made available by rezoning to create community/ social amenity space in the village.
- Complete footpath to New Cemetery – 1st section for completion early 2021
- Upgrade the playground and ensure all equipment and grounds are maintained
- Wild flower etc along North Longford rebel trail.
- Upper area of Mary St EMO station/ St. Mary's Church – Needs redesigning
- Lamp pole at the St. Mary's Church removed to underground cabling
- Provision of Community / Village garden and allotment to include projects to support bees
- Bus Shelter in the village
- Pedestrian crossing from St. Mary's Church to Cost cutter
- Upgrade all village lighting to LED
- Traffic calming measures through the village
- Crash Barrier along Rebel trail – where walk is under the road
- Coffee shop, education and training centre somewhere near school and community centre.
- Removal of hedge/ditch along the 198 to give clear vision on traffic from Ballinamuck
 - Also pelican lights and signage approaching Monaduff park
