I Aisling Conway resident of Battery Court wish to object to the proposed plan for the land around Battery Court and the Latin Quarter development of the Barracks.

Firstly the cycle/ pathway from the barracks in to and through Battery Court will be hazardous to the community and the residents in this estate. We have St Christopher Independence living here in Battery Court and the welfare and safety of these individuals will be at risk if these right of ways are left open to the public.
