Notice of proposed development: N4 Cooleeny (Shroid) Safety Scheme

Pursuant to the requirements of the above, notice is hereby given of a proposal by Longford County Council to undertake junction realignment and street improvement works on the N4 at Cooleeny, Co. Longford.

The proposed development will consist of the following:

- 1. Construction of an access road 250m in length between the N4 and the existing 3 commercial units. Access road to be constructed on existing hard surfaced areas which currently form the hard shoulder of the N4 the surfaced carparking areas of the three premises and the materials storage yard of the builders providers.
- 2. Realignment of a section of local road L5167, approx. 100m in length. The existing jn of this local road with the N4 will be reconstructed.
- 3. Construction of new boundary walls and fences between the commercial properties and the new access road.

Plans and particulars of the proposed development will be available for inspection or purchase at a fee, not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy, at the Planning Department offices of Longford County Council, Áras an Chontae, Great Water Street, Longford during official public opening hours, excluding weekends and bank holidays from **Friday 31**st **January 2020** up to and including **Friday 28**th **February 2020**.
