Notice is hereby given that in accordance with the requirements of the above regulations that Longford County Council proposes to undertake the following works:

Proposed alteration and extension to No. 24 Congress Terrace and Construction of new Semi-detached 2 storey 3 bed unit to side/rear garden area and all associated site works at 24 Congress Terrace, St. Michael's Road, Townparks, Longford.

The proposed development will consist of a.) demolition of existing extension to rear of No 24, alteration to internal layout and construction of new kitchen and dining area at the rear ground floor and 2 bedrooms at the rear first floor.

b.) Proposed construction of semi-detached two storey 3-bedroom unit adjoining unit 24.

The proposed development will also consist of construction of new pedestrian gate to the front SW fronting St. Michael's Road and rear SE fronting N63, repair of existing boundary wall to front and side, construction of division wall and fence, private open spaces, footpaths, replacement of existing door and windows, removal of existing chimney at Unit 24, diversion of existing services pipes, connection to existing foul, surface water and watermain and existing utilities and hard & soft landscaped areas.

Plans and particulars of the proposed development will be available for inspection or purchase at a fee, not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy, at the offices of Longford County Council, Aras an Chontae, Great Water Street, Longford during official public opening hours, excluding weekends and bank holidays, from Friday 28th January 2022 up to and including Friday 11th March 2022.
