## Temporary Closing of Roads – Roads Act 1993 (Section 75)

Longford County Council has made an order to close the road described hereunder,

**Road to be Closed:** N63 Ballymacormack to Lanesboro at  
• Aghnaskea Canal Bridge, Killashee.

**Date:** From Monday 10 July 2023 to Friday 4 August 2023

**Hours of Closure:** From Monday 8am to Friday 6pm each week during closure period. (Road opened to Traffic each weekend during closure period)

**Detour Route:** **From Longford:** Traffic to divert at Ballymacormack. Take the R397 to Terlicken via Kenagh. Turn right and take R392 to Lanesboro.

**From Lanesboro:** Traffic to divert at Lanesboro. Take the R392 to Terlicken. Turn left and take the R397 to Ballymacormack.

**Traffic exiting Longford will be unable to access Killashee village along the N63 during the hours of closure.**

**Traffic exiting Lanesborough will be permitted local access to Killashee village along the N63 during hours of closure.**

In the interest of road safety, you are requested to follow diversions and heed all signs.

This closure is to facilitate pavement improvement works on the N63 Longford between the Royal Canal Bridge and Killashee Village.
