Notice is hereby given in accordance with the requirements of the above regulations that Longford County Council proposes to undertake the following works:

**Proposed 160 square metre burial ground extension to the east of the existing St. John's Church Graveyard, Battery Road, Abbeycartron, Longford Town. The area relating to the proposed was previously granted planning permission for residential use under reference 00/700044. The proposed development relates to works to Record of Protected Structure (RPS) No. 14 and 18 of the current CDP 2021 – 2027.**

Plans and particulars of the proposed development will be available for inspection or purchase at a fee, not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy, at the Planning Department offices of Longford County Council, Áras an Chontae, Great Water Street, Longford during official public opening hours, excluding weekends and bank holidays from Friday 30<sup>th</sup> June up to and including Monday 31<sup>st</sup> July.
