Notice is hereby given that Longford County proposes to carry out the following
development:

**Pedestrian and Cycle Improvement Scheme on the R392 between St. Matthew's National School
and Moygh Road Junction, Ballymahon Co. Longford**

The aim of this project is to improve pedestrian and cycling infrastructure within Ballymahon, Co. Longford.
This project will include:

- Segregated pedestrian and cycle facilities for approximately 350m along the R392 between Saint Matthews National School and Moygh Road Junction (L1128).
- Widening of existing footpaths.
- Realignment and narrowing of carriageway, junction tightening works and provision of 2 no. raised pedestrian crossing along the R392.
- The works will also include the construction of a new boundary wall, additional signage and road markings.
- All other associated site works.

Plans and particulars of the proposed development will be available to purchase at a fee, not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy, at the Planning Department offices of Longford County Council, Áras an Chontae, Great Water Street, Longford during official public opening hours, excluding weekends and bank holidays (Subject to Covid-19 restrictions) from 31st January 2025 up to and including 3rd March 2025.
