### Temporary Closing of Roads - Roads Act 1993 (Section 75) Road Regulations 1994 (Section 12)

Longford County Council hereby gives notice that it has made an order to close the roads in Longford described hereunder:

**Date:** Wednesday 16th July to 13th August 2025

**Road to be Closed:** L-1038 - Esker to Derrynacross

**Hours of Closure:** 9am - 5pm

**Alternative Routes are as follows:**

- Traffic from Esker to Aughnaclyffe should divert to the R-194 and follow R-194 to Ballinalee. In Ballinalee turn left on to L-1056 and then left onto L-5093. Aghnashannagh to Derrynacross.
- Traffic from Aughnaclyffe to Esker should turn left onto L-5093 at Derrynacross and proceed to Ballinalee and then via the R194 to Doherty's cross.

Local access as far as Esker Old Hall bridge will be maintained, but there will be no through access at the bridge for safety reasons.

This road closure is required for essential bridge repair work at Esker Old Hall Bridge.

**Road to be Closed:** L-1055 - Killinacarrow to Garvagh

**Hours of Closure:** 9am - 5pm

**Alternative Routes are as follows:**

- At junction of R-194 and L-1055 (Doherty's Cross), continue on R194 to Ballinalee and follow L-1056 to Garvagh.
- At junction of L-1055 and L-1056 in Garvagh, continue to Ballinalee and follow R194 to Killinacarrow (Doherty's Cross).

Local access as far as Killinacarrow Bridge will be maintained, but there will be no through access at the bridge for safety reasons.

This road closure is required for essential bridge repair work at Killinacarrow Bridge.

### Planning and Development Acts 2000 (As Amended) Part 8 - Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (As Amended)

Notice is hereby given in accordance with the requirements of the above regulations that Longford County Council proposes to undertake the following works:

Proposed storm water management system to separate the existing combined sewer to facilitate the re-development of the former Officers Building, Abbeycarton, Longford, Co. Longford, a Protected Structure, situated within the grounds of Sean Connolly Barracks.

**The proposed development will consist of:**

- The provision of a separate stormwater drainage system to discharge stormwater generated from roof and local hardstanding areas of the existing Officers Building and proposed extension only.
- System to include a gravity stormwater sewer to the perimeter of the building, which is to discharge to an onsite stormwater storage system, which will in-turn discharge stormwater to the Camlin River via a flow control device.

Plans and particulars of the proposed development will be available for inspection or purchase at a fee, not exceeding the reasonable cost of making the copy, at the office of Longford County Council, Aras an Chontae, Great Water Street, Longford during official public opening hours, excluding weekends and bank holidays from 4th July 2025 up to and including 31st July 2025.

Submissions with respect to the proposed development, dealing with the proper planning and sustainable development of the area, may be made in writing to Longford County Council, headed 'Part 8 - Proposed storm water management system to facilitate re-development of the former Officers Building, Abbeycarton, Longford' and addressed to the Planning Section, Longford County Council, Aras an Chontae, Great Water Street, Longford Town to arrive no later than 4.00pm on 15th August 2025.
