



Construction Management

This drawing is to be read in conjunction with Flynn Fury Environmental Consultants Natura Impact Statement.

The appointed contractor shall be aware that the works are to be carried out in a sensitive natural environment.

During the construction phase, the proposed works shall comply with British Standard 5228 'Noise Control on Construction and open sites Part 1. Code of practice for basic information and procedures for noise control.'

Noise levels from the proposed development shall not be so loud, so continuous, so repeated, of such duration or pitch or occurring at such times as to give reasonable cause for annoyance to a person in any premises in the neighbourhood or to a person lawfully using any public place. In particular, the rated noise levels from the proposed development shall not constitute reasonable grounds for complaint as provided for in B.S. 4142. Method for rating industrial noise affecting mixed residential and industrial areas.

Measures shall also be put in place to mitigate dust and vibration throughout the course of the works.
