

Clondra to Tarmonbarry Greenway

Project Objectives

- Provide a vital link between the planned Greenways on the Roscommon side of the River Shannon, and the current termination point of the Royal Canal Greenway at Richmond Harbour, Clondra
 - Provide for the economic growth of west County Longford bordering the River Shannon
 - Provide a safe off-road cycling and walking amenity for the residents of Clondra and Tarmonbarry
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Timeline

- Preliminary Business Case being prepared under the EU Just Transition Fund, to be completed in August 2026
- Preliminary Business Case assesses route options, and will recommend an Emerging Preferred Option
- The timing of future phases of the project is dependent on:
 - Availability of funding
 - Liaison with Waterways Ireland on the use of Tarmonbarry Weir



Main Route Considerations

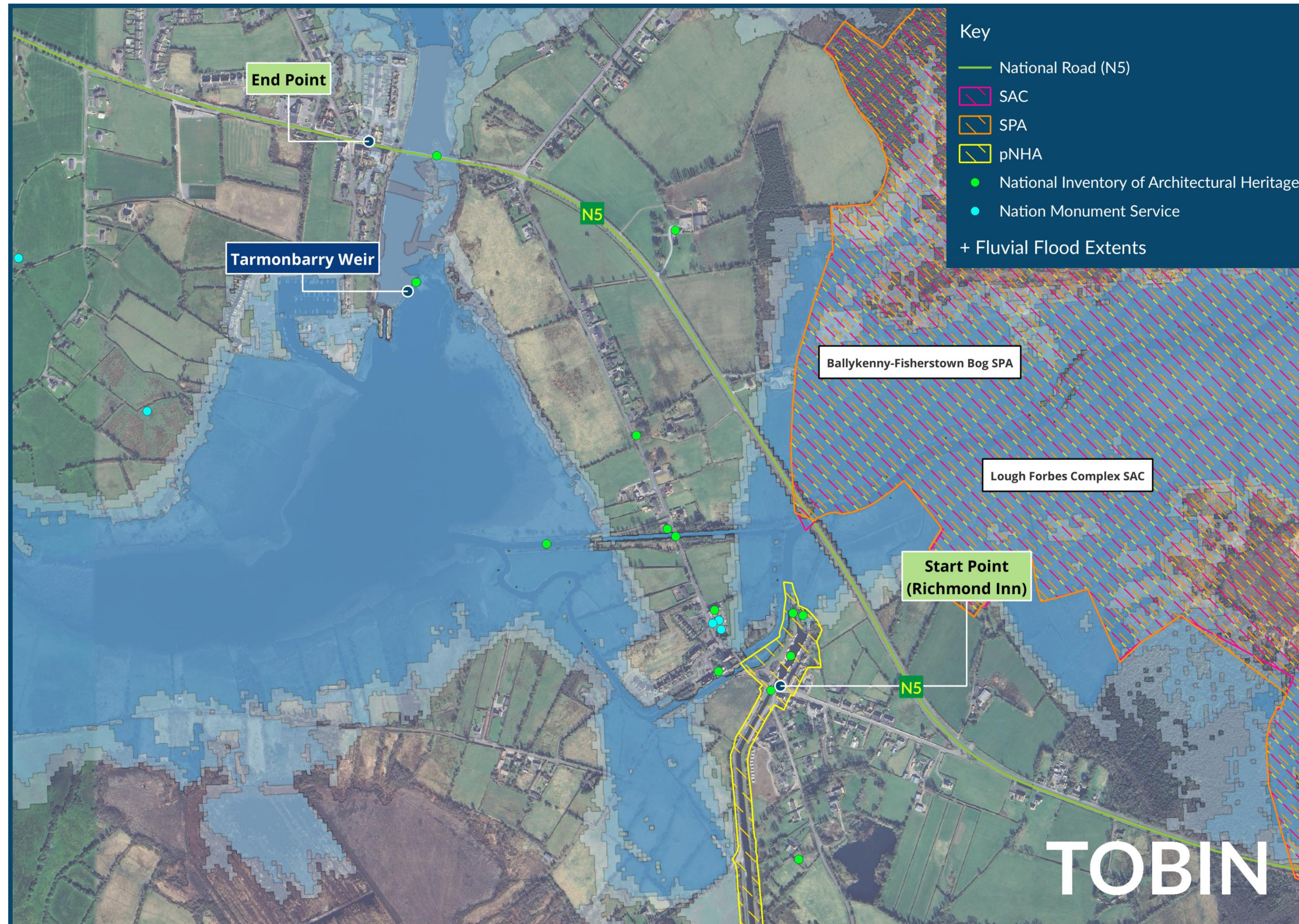
- Off-road to the greatest possible extent, for user safety
 - Usable for the majority of the year (i.e. avoid flood risk zones)
 - Affordable
 - Minimise impact on existing land uses
 - Minimise impact on existing residents
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- Lands are to be acquired (not permissive access).
This is TII requirement for Greenways
- Surface is to be sealed (i.e. tarmac)
- Greenway is to be designed to:
 - National Cycle Manual, and TII Rural Cycleway Design (Offline & Greenway)
 - Approx. 3.5m corridor
 - Desirable max. gradient 3%

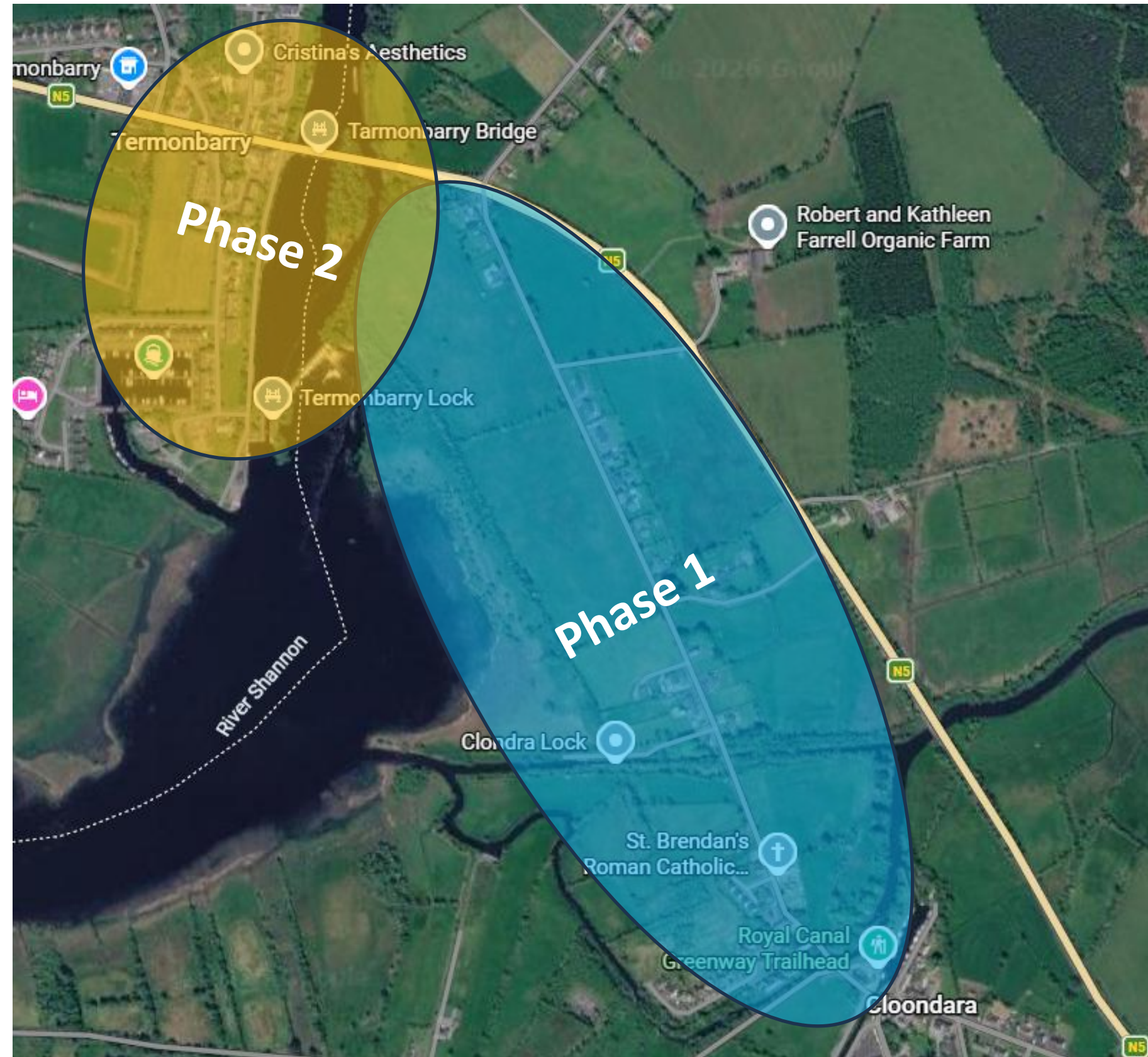
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Route Phasing

- Phase 2: Crossing the River Shannon



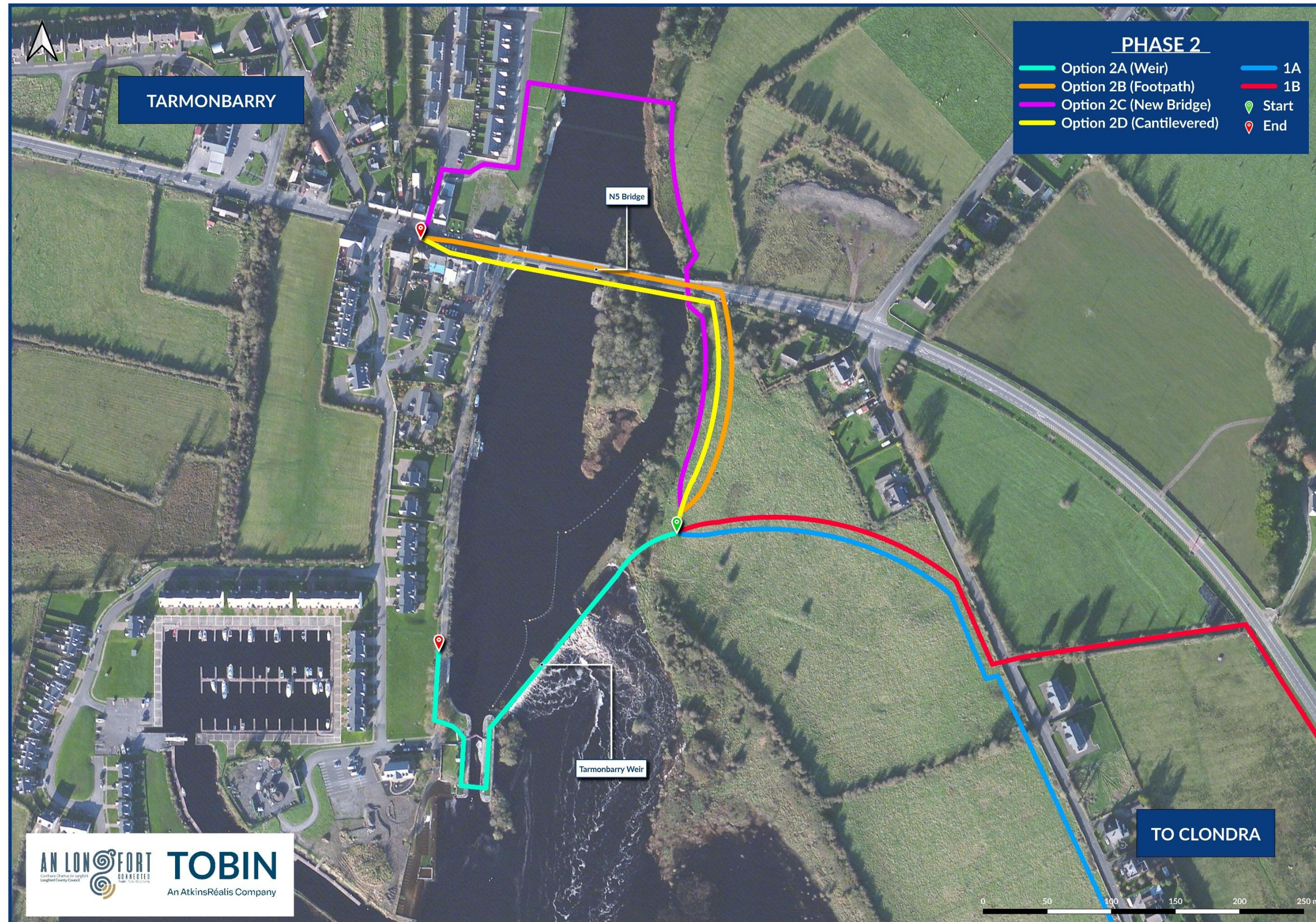
Phase 1: Clondra to the eastern bank of the River Shannon
