Legislative Procedure for Traffic Calming Measures under the Road Traffic Act 1994

Under the Road Traffic Act 1994 (As Amended), a road authority may, in the interest of the safety and convenience of road users, provide such traffic calming measures as they consider desirable in respect of public roads in their charge.

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act 1994 (As Amended) of the following scheme:

Traffic Calming measures by way of Speed ramps for the Bracklin park housing estate, Edgeworthstown. Road no. L-10916

The proposed scheme will consist of the provision of 5 no. speed ramps in appropriate locations and in accordance with the Department of Transport's guidelines to act as traffic calming measure within the Bracklin Park housing estate. In accordance with Section 38 of the above-mentioned legislation, Longford County Council, as the competent roads authority, has concluded that the above scheme complies with the relevant section of the legislation, based on the nature, size, and location of the proposed scheme. All submissions received will be considered and will form part of the Chief Executive's report on the public consultation process.
