Landscaping

As suggested in the images above, the planting of approximately six Poplar (or something similar) trees is necessary for a number of reasons.

1. The view of the site from the crossroads is extremely bare and devoid of flora.
2. The semi-circle of trees puts a focal point on the sculpture.
3. The use of such trees is an extremely economical way to present a very pleasant backdrop to the installation.
4. At night the up-lights cast a shadow of the sculpture on the tree giving a great lighting contrast to the overall setting.
