- (i) I call upon Longford County Council to erect safety signs regarding dangerous undulations on two roads that should be on the programme for road upgrades in 2026.
 - Ledwithstown Ballymahon to Derrycolumb Newtowncashel
 - Corlea to Kenagh Village
- (ii) I call upon Ballymahon Municipal District to write to the Minister of the Department of Housing, Local Government and Heritage and the Minister of THE Department of Climate, Energy and the Environment to procure funding to facilitate the remedial works required at the disused and abandoned Piggery at Elfeet, Newtowncashel. This financial assistance is required to prevent a major environmental disaster in the area which are on the shores of Lough Ree.
