Councillor Pat O'Toole

- (i) I call on Longford County Council to consider under the Active Travel Scheme the provision of a footpath / cycle path from the Moigh Road Junction Ballymahon to the entrance of the Royal Canal Greenway at Drinan Ballymahon.
- (ii) I call on Longford County Council to open discussions with Bús Eireann on the possibility of providing two bus shelters at Upper Main Street Ballymahon.
- (iii) I call on Longford County to take in charge the lane beside Bridgeways Family Resource Centre that leads to Ballymahon Soccer pitch and the local vets practice.

Councillor Paul Ross

- (I) That Longford County Council seek to take in charge the road from Main St Ballymahon up to the Soccer Pitch in Ballymahon. This road is very narrow with poor sight lines onto the main street. This road also accesses 2 very busy businesses with constant pedestrian and vehicular traffic on the road. I would request that this road be taken in charge in the interest of public safety.
- (II) I call on Longford County Council to upgrade the drainage at the Ball Alley in Legan village as the current drainage system is not fit for purpose and causes regular flooding which affects the freshwater well, which is located very close to the drain and is widely used by the people of the parish.

Councillor Martin Skelly

(i) I call upon Longford county Council to commission a report on Forthill crossroads Newtowncashel, with a view to access and safety for transport approaching the junction. This is a dangerous crossroads where accidents repeatedly happen, and action needs to be taken before a really serious collision occurs. This is one of the main access roads to Newtowncashel, Saints island and Barley Harbour.
