Councillor David Cassidy

- (i) I call upon Longford County Council in conjunction with the Regeneration Dept and/or Active Travel to explore the possibility of and seek funding for constructing a public walkway from the village of Ballinamuck to the 98 Bar/Johnnys Cottage whilst retaining as much of the existing hedgerow and tree's as possible along this route.
- (ii) I call upon Longford County Council to explore the potential of and carry out a Low-Cost Safety Scheme (LCSS) where the L-5092 meets the L-1041 at Esker, Killoe to improve visibility at the Stop sign when turning onto the L-1041 where visibility is significantly obstructed for road users to see oncoming traffic.

Councillor Garry Murtagh

- (i) I call on Longford County Council to implement a low cost safety scheme at Gelsha Junction
- (ii) I call on Longford County Council to seek climate adaption funding for the R198 at the Corinagha junction to include improvements to sight lines and the widening of the junction
- (iii) I call on Longford County Council when developing the new car park in Derrycasin woods/Mullinalaghta to make provision for the relocation of the bottle banks at Purth church. Every area should have a bottle bank in their community to promote recycling.

Councillor Colin Dalton

- (i) I call on Longford County Council to carry out an audit on our road signs where they are damaged and need to be cleaned for our road users in the Granard MD, and junction markings to be refreshed where needed.
- (ii) I call on Longford County Council to place an advertisement in the paper and on social media to remind our land owners its hedge cutting season again. There has been great improvement on hedge cutting and this will help make our roads safer for our pedestrians and drivers.

I call on Longford County Council to undertake urgent works at the new cemetery in Granard, which is under the ownership of the Council. Concerns have been raised
