As our elderly people are house bound without water and notwithstanding most farmers (under the guidelines of the Department of Agriculture) have cattle in sheds without water for days.

I call on Longford County Council to put in place, in all three Municipal Districts, a permanent programme for signage on all roads and public spaces under the aegis of Longford County Council to include the following:
