I call on Longford County Council to address the health and safety concerns, and in certain locations the anti social issues, regarding the need for additional lighting:

- Dring Public Car Park
- Public car park and amenities in front of Moyne NS and Moyne CS
- St Francis Church, Moyne

Councillor Turlough McGovern

- (i) I call on Longford County Council to provide an update on the dereliction in Colmcille Terrace and a timeline for the restoration and completion of construction works. There are a number of Health and Safety concerns notably fly tipping/dumping, illegal trespassing, vermin and rat infestation. The residents deserve better and Granard Traders deserve better on one of the busiest approach roads to the main business town in North Longford.
- (ii) I call on Longford County Council to address safety issue for motorists at Howdens Cross on R194 . Due to the angle of the road on an extremely sharp bend is leading to a lot of accidents for road users. I'm inundated with calls from people and neighbouring farmers with concern for the welfare of pedestrians, cycles, and motorists.

Councillor Pdraig McNamara

- (i) I call on Longford County Council to provide an update on the proposed connection of the Derragh and Finea walkways, and advise what stage the project is currently at.
- (ii) I call on Longford County Council to examine the extension of the existing footpath at Ballinacross along the R194 (53.7787409, -7.4765212), with a view to improving pedestrian safety and connectivity in the area.

Councillor David Cassidy

- (i) I call on Longford County Council to seek the necessary funding and carry out road safety improvement works at the dangerous bend/junction at Ballynascraw on the R194 Regional Road between Ballinalee and Granard, in the interest of improving safety for all road users.
