I call on Longford Municipal District and Longford County Council to formally support the development and delivery of a community-led cultural and family festival to be held at The Mall, Longford, from 24th–26th July 2026, and to provide appropriate logistical, operational, promotional, and administrative assistance to ensure its safe, inclusive, and successful.

- (i) I call on Longford Municipal District to examine and report on the feasibility of developing the lands adjacent to the Council buildings as an all-day public car park, and potential benefits to town centre businesses, workers, and permit holders.
- (ii) I call on Longford County Council to carry out a full inspection of the windows in the houses located in Park Villas estate, Longford, due to reports from residents that the rubber seals around many windows have deteriorated or are completely gone, resulting in significant drafts, persistent condensation, and damp conditions which are contributing to mould issues within the homes.

Following this inspection, the Council should assess the extent of the problem and outline what remedial works are required to ensure the homes meet appropriate housing standards, including the repair or replacement of defective window seals or units where necessary.
