Why does Planning process personal data?


The Planning department processes your personal data to:

- Provide proper planning and sustainable development of County Longford
- Promote and facilitate the development of sustainable communities and enterprise
- Ensure the protection of the natural and built heritage and amenity of the county.

What personal data does Planning process?

The following is a list of personal data that we process:

- Name
- Address
- Development address
- Email address
- Personal Public Services Number (PPSN)
- Health data
- Land ownership
- Phone number
- Financial details.
- Possibly images from security CCTV in Council buildings





What does the law say about how we process your personal data?

Here is a situation where the law says we can use your personal data:

Situation	Example
To allow us to carry out a task in the public interest and or in our official duty as a local authority as allowed under Local Government legislation.	 Recording details of people who submit a planning application under: the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) the Planning and Development Regulation 2001 (as amended).

Who will Planning share your personal data with?

We may share your personal data with the following but only when necessary:

- An Bord Pleanála
- Department of Agriculture
- Department of Housing, Local Government and Heritage
- Elected representatives
- Financial institutions
- Health Service Executive (HSE)
- Uisce Éireann (formerly Irish Water)
- Legal representatives
- Local government auditor
- Other government departments
- The public (for example, planning applications)
- National Transport Authority.
