Why does Civil Defence process personal data?

The Civil Defence department processes your personal data to provide:

- A backup service to the local emergency services
- Training and to fulfil your contract with us if you are a volunteer with the Civil Defence.

What personal data does Civil Defence process?

The following is a list of personal data that we process:

- Name
- Address
- Date of birth
- Tax registration number/Personal Public Services Number (PPSN)
- Email address
- Financial details
- Phone number
- Driving licence or learner's permit
- Health data
- Possibly images taken from security cameras when entering Council buildings



What does the law say about how we process your personal data?

Here are the three situations where the law says we can use your personal data:

Situation	Example
To protect the vital interest of an individual	When dealing with an emergency
To allow us to carry out a task in the public interest and or in our official duty as a local authority as allowed under Local Government legislation	When recruiting volunteers under the Civil Defence Act 2002
To carry out a contract	When paying for supplies or services

Who will Civil Defence share your personal data with?

We may share your personal data with the following, but only when necessary:

- An Garda Síochána
- Civil Defence Volunteers
- Department of Defence
- General Practitioners (GPs)
- ♦ Health Service Executive (HSE)
- Training facilitators
- Tusla, the Child and Family Agency.
