### Nursing Home Programme

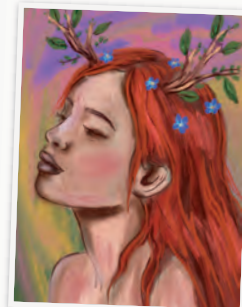
**Month of December Countywide.**

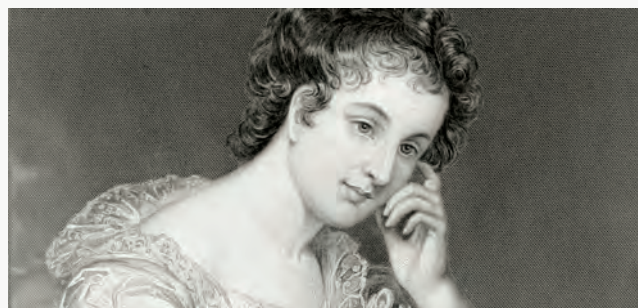

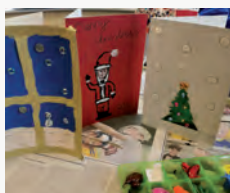

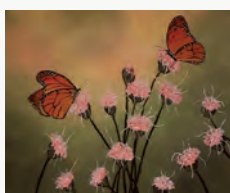
